# **Banks in the Spotlight: Corporate Responsibility at Work**

This month we spotlight the 2023 ABA Foundation Community Commitment Award winner for Community and Economic Development: **United Bank**, of Vienna, Va., for its Power of Partnership program. The program, which

works alongside Jubilee Housing, focuses on maintaining housing affordability in Washington, D.C., neighborhoods and slowing or reversing the displacement of low- to moderate-income families. Through the partnership, Jubilee Housing has preserved and/or developed 484 units of affordable housing and created 24,333 square feet of commercial space for businesses dedicated to serving low-income households. More than \$75 million has been invested through 23 loans over the past 20 years, all within less than 2 square miles.

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
