

**Live Remote Proctoring Policy**  
**(Effective July 1, 2026)**

Live Remote Proctoring (LRP) is offered as a convenience and may not be available or appropriate for all candidates, locations, devices, or network environments. The Program reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to require a candidate to test at an approved testing center or to use an alternate delivery method to protect exam security, ensure a reliable testing experience, or address repeated technical disruptions. Candidates are responsible for ensuring that their testing environment, device, and internet connection meet Program requirements. Failure to maintain minimum technical requirements may result in rescheduling or a requirement to test at a testing center.

If a candidate experiences repeated technical disruptions during LRP (including device, network, platform, or proctoring connectivity issues) that prevent completion of the exam, the Program may require that subsequent attempts be completed at a testing center. Generally, a testing center attempt may be required after two (2) or more materially disrupted LRP sessions within a rolling twelve (12) month period, unless an approved accommodation or exception applies.

Candidates who need an accommodation or exception due to a documented disability or medical condition may submit a request through the Program's accommodation process. The Program will consider reasonable accommodations consistent with exam security and integrity requirements.
